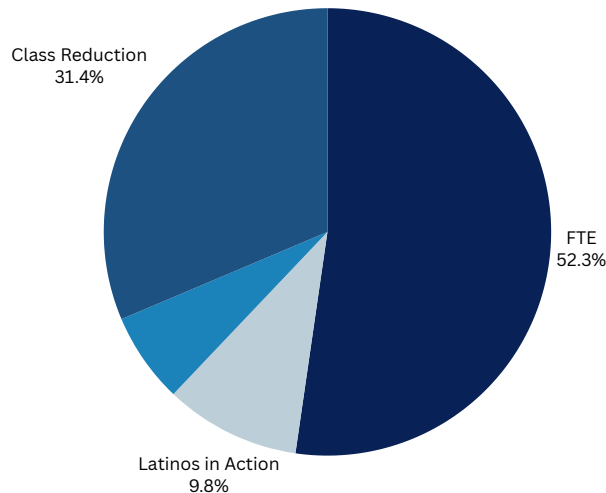
SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN

- Helping to cover the cost of one Language Arts teacher

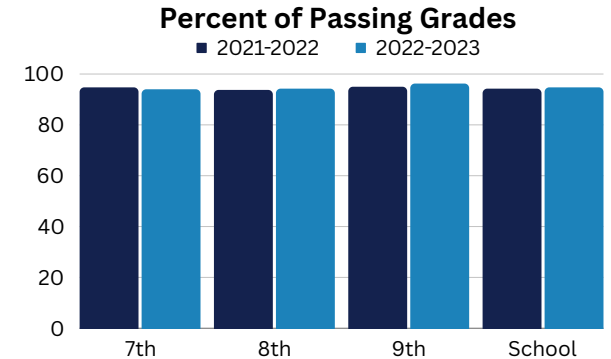
