**The purpose of the Timberline Middle School Community Council is to:**

- identify the strengths, weaknesses and needs of Timberline Middle School
- help develop the **School Improvement Plan**
- help plan **Professional Development Days**—(The SCC gives suggestions for teacher development days and attends some of these meetings.)
- help plan **Safe Routing**— (The SCC helps negotiate safe walking routes for students and adequate bussing. As a team, the SCC is concerned for the safety of each student.)
- develop a plan to use **Trust Land Money** for Timberline's critical academic needs
- serve as a communication channel between the school and the community

**Members of the council include:**

- the school principal
- school employees (up to 4 voting members)
- parents or guardians of students who attend the school from six separate geographical areas (see map on back)
- PTSA, Alpine School Board member, and/or others as needed

**The areas that are open this year for application are areas 1, 3, 4 and 6 (see map on back)**

- Only parents or guardians of students who will be attending Timberline at least one year during the initial term of office qualify as candidates for election to the school community council.
- Parents or guardians are invited to apply for the designated geographic area in which they reside.
- Those members that are elected will serve a **2-year** term beginning July 1, 2007.

**Elections for new members of the council will be held:**

- **Tuesday, March 6 through Friday, March 9** at Timberline in the Main Office.
- **Friday, March 9 and Saturday March 10** at Timberline **before the school Grand Concert.**

Only parents or guardians of students who will be attending Timberline next year and live in areas 1, 3, 4 and 6 may vote. A simple majority of those parents or guardians voting for each area will determine the election. Results of the election will be made available to the public upon request. If you are interested in applying to serve on the Timberline Middle School Community Council, please fill out the application below and return it to the Timberline Main Office by **Friday, March 2, 2007, 3:00 PM.**

Remember, only residents living in the areas of 1, 3, 4 and 6 need apply.
