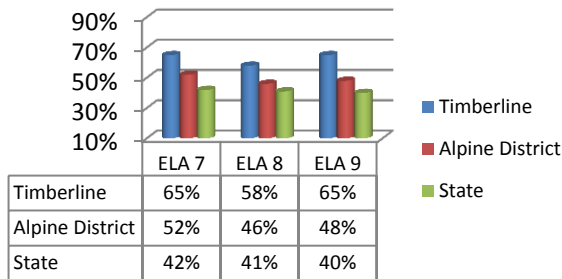


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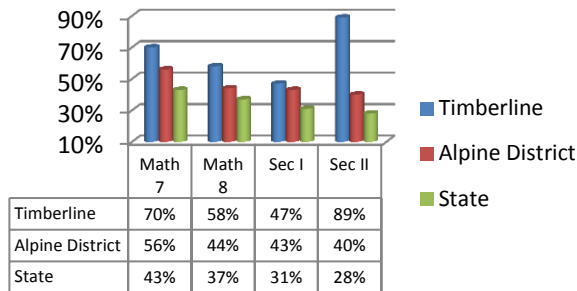

Timberline Middle School Report Card

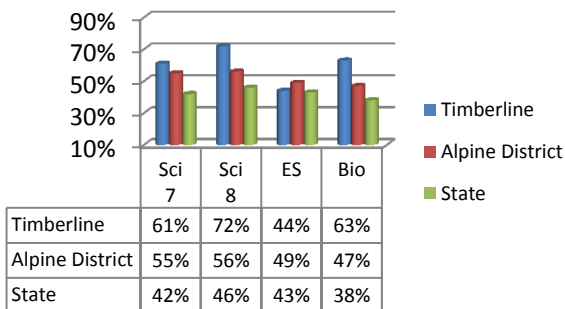
Language Arts SAGE Proficiency 2014

TIMBERLINE RECEIVES AN A GRADE

The State recently announced a grade for each school in Utah based on last year's test results. We are pleased to report that Timberline received an "A" grade. This grade is calculated using both proficiency and growth scores in Language Arts, Math, and Science. In comparison to other schools throughout the state, Timberline performed well, scoring in the top five of all middle schools in language arts and math and in the top ten in science.

For several years, over 90% of Timberline students have reached proficiency in all areas of testing. When studying last year's test results, a significant decrease in the number of students reaching proficiency will be noted. It is important to keep in mind that this is a new test with a new benchmark. We expect our scores will improve over time as they have in the past. When the math core was revised and a new test was administered in 2009, for instance, scores predictably dropped, but have consistently risen each year. We expect the same will happen with the SAGE test as our teachers work in collaborative teams to improve instruction to ensure high levels of proficiency and significant levels of growth for each student.

Proficiency in tested subjects is just one of many desired outcomes of schooling. We must keep testing in proper perspective—while it is important, we remain dedicated to educating the whole child so that each will become responsible, caring individuals who know how to continually learn.

ACCREDITATION

This year Timberline Middle School went through the accreditation process. Accreditation is a method of quality assurance designed to effectively drive student performance and continuous improvement in education.

As part of the accreditation process, Timberline Middle School conducted a thorough self-evaluation which included stakeholder feedback. We were also visited by an AdvancEd external review team who completed a comprehensive evaluation of our educational practices.

As a measure of performance, the accrediting body uses The Index of Education Quality (IEQ). The IEQ results include information about how the school is performing compared to other accredited schools. As indicated below, Timberline scored above average in all three domains including teaching and learning, leadership capacity, and resource utilization:

Through the accreditation process, Timberline was able to demonstrate exemplary levels of student performance and provide evidence of stakeholder engagement and satisfaction resulting in a recommendation for a five year full accreditation, the highest recommendation given by AdvancEd.
