NCAA High School Requirements

(Eligibility for college athletics)

- English: 4 units
- Math: 4 units
- Science: 2 units
- Additional course in English, Math or Science: 1 unit
- Social Studies: 2 units
- Additional core courses: 4 units (in any of the above areas, foreign language areas, or philosophy)
- Must also achieve a minimum combined SAT or ACT score based on core course GPA.

Core course completion no later than high school graduation date.
