Kevin Thomas: Grants

1. Review of the grants

Professional development:

- a. Band Texas Music Educators Conference (virtual),
- b. Coaches--books for teachers—another book right now might not be the way to go.
Can we approve this and wait and see if teachers will show up?

Technology:

- a. English dept apple tv,
- b. fine arts camera and mics,
- c. PE pickleball striping—this is a capital improvement project and should not be funded by

SCC

- d. social studies chromebooks,
- e. foreign language quizlet

There are five more teachers who want classroom microphones that could be paid for out of technology money

There are two rooms in the satellite with a high need for systems and 6 rooms in the main building with a high need. It's \$1383 per system.

CTE grant for ipads—why not chromebooks? The foods teacher uses the ipads every day with her class. If the sewing teacher needs ipads, she doesn't have access for them. Ipads fit better in the space than chromebooks.

Stacey: Coaching made available at a different time than lunch and offer compensation for time spent outside of contract hours. We should make teachers aware that SCC money can be used for them to collaborate in the school.

How can we help teachers survive right now? What are the teachers already doing that we can enhance?

Stacey recommends to remind teachers that they can use SCC money for team time.

Tiffany makes a motion to approve the two professional development requests. Marnee second. Discussion to add enough money for all four subs and for lunch. Vote was unanimous.

Marnee moves to approve technology without the pickleball. Amy Kunz seconds. Vote was unanimous. Stacey abstains from the voting. Kevin adds that he will come back to the teachers and remind them of the appropriate uses of this money, specifically that it can be used for team time/activities.

Miss Kepas earned a certification last year using SCC money and has been teaching other teachers and students with her certification. Stacey suggested that we offer that training to all teachers to help themselves and students handle the stress of the pandemic.

Kevin: This could be accomplished on a teacher training day.

Stacey: In a dream world, we give everyone trauma training, because covid is a trauma. Teachers could be paid for their time getting mental health training.

Sheldon: At the beginning of the year, there was a training given to identify signs of trauma in kids.

Tiffany: That's a wrap.

Add the sound system to the action items for next time.

Stacey suggests an email vote for the sound systems.

Amy Kunz: Next meeting is in January

Tiffany: Meeting is concluded.
