- ✓ Kim Potts called meeting to order at 3:08.

- ✓ Trustlands – everyone has copy of budget and it was reviewed.
- ✓ Discussion on where we would like to put extra funds, if applicable.
- ✓ Kelly did not want money to be spent on composition notebooks. The council agreed.

- ✓ Jenn asked if some monies could be put towards special education instead of an hourly math teacher.
- ✓ Lauren Burton (math teacher) talked to us about math tutors. She feels like it is very helpful for kids that plan in it. She feels like it's not being utilized like it could be because teachers are not really helping. She is trying to get teacher "buy-in" for the math tutoring.
- ✓ Math tutors = \$2000
- ✓ Trustlands money for classrooms can make a school closed.
- ✓ We took 18,000 from summer days and \$2,000 from benefits.
- ✓ Additional money can be used for summer days and benefits, if needed.
- ✓ \$10,000 will go to class size reduction in math.
- ✓ Kim made a motion to approve the budget. Kelly seconded it.
- ✓ Vista's new principal will be announced tomorrow.
- ✓ Counseling: Lagoon day stipulations were discussed. Students can have no failing grades to participate in yearbook day. Butch and Tom talked about a resiliency clinic.
