# Why do we have TEAL Time?

TEAL Time's *fundamental* purpose is to provide students with an opportunity to remediate with their teachers **during the school day**.

It's that simple!

# Why make changes?

## Teal Time is Awesome!

- Every teacher needs a chance to meet with every student
- Any time during the school day should be productive, and enriching
- Students need the opportunity and motivation to be successful

## But we think it can be even better.

- Priority Days
- Minimize games, play time, free time
- Including C level grades in remediation process





## Grade Slips

Grade slips for TEAL  
will be divided  
into three  
sections

- All A's and B's:  
**colored paper**  
*with watermark*
- Any F's or I's:  
**white paper**
- Any C's or D's:  
**buff-colored  
paper**



# White Grade Slip

If you receive a **white grade slip**, go directly to your teacher's room. You will get seated **FIRST**, because you likely need the most help from your teacher.





# Priority Days of the Week

If you have a white grade slip you will be required to follow these Priority Days:

Tuesday and Wednesday: MATH

Thursday: SCIENCE

Friday: ALL OTHER CLASSES

For example: if you have a white slip because of an F in Math *and* an F in Science, and it's a Thursday, you MUST go to Science.

If you have an F in Math and Choir, and it's a Friday, you MUST go to Choir.



# Additional Scenarios for Priority Days

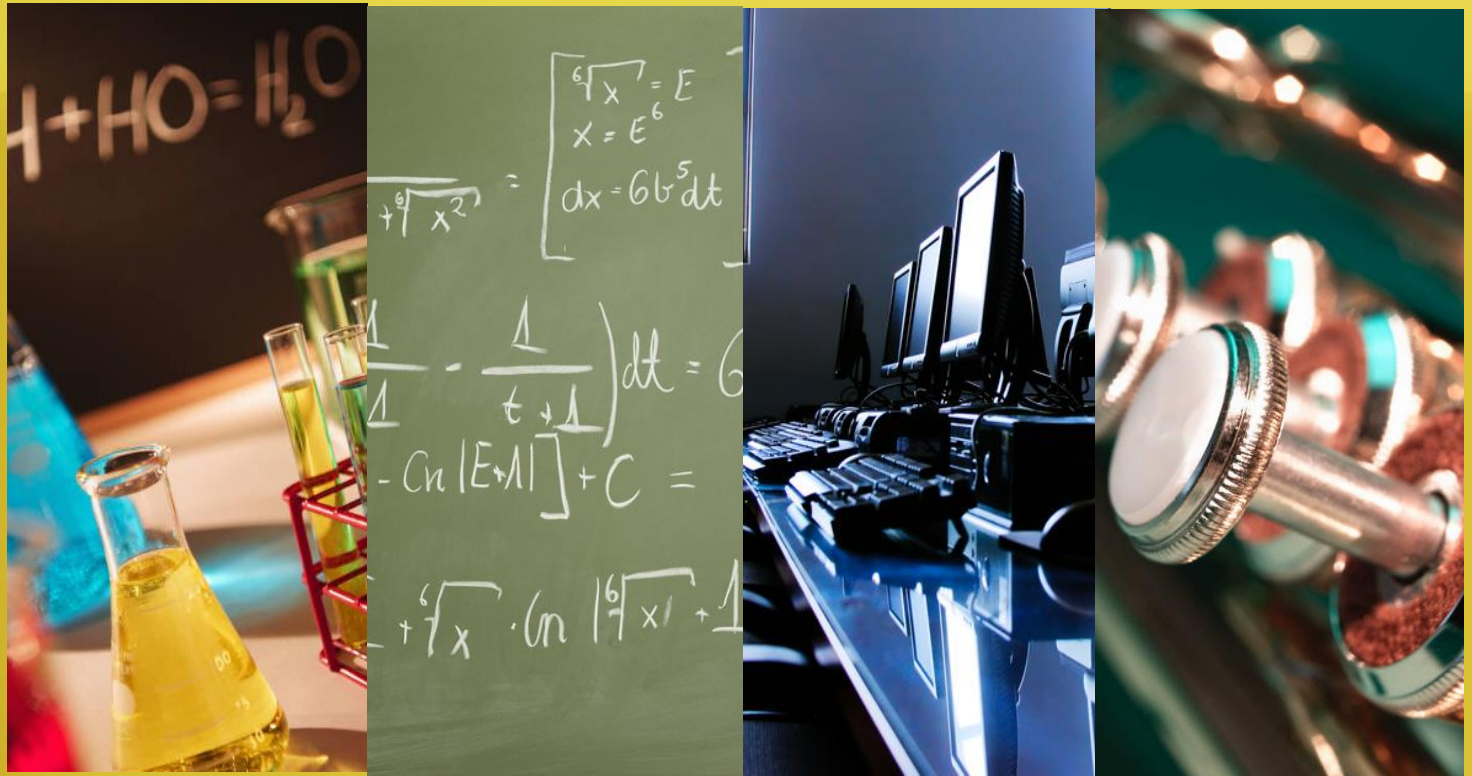
If it's a Tuesday, and you have an F in Math and an F in Science, you go to MATH!

If it's a Friday, and you have an F in English and an F in Art, go to English. (still use Core classes as a first choice)

If it's Wednesday and you have an F in Gym and an F in Art, go to either. (Both are electives)

If you only have one F or I on any given day, go meet with that teacher.

***Priority Days will be posted in main halls on posters, but you may want to write them in your planner.***



**Priority Days will give you an opportunity to meet with all of your teachers. Core and Elective.**



# Colored Grade Slip

If you receive a colored grade slip with a blackhawk watermark it means you have all A's and B's. You may participate in an enrichment activity.

- Media Center (read, check out books)
- Auditorium (educational film, speaker)
- Gym (structured sports and games)



Giving you an additional learning experience during the school day is important!

*You may meet with teachers if they have room*

# Other opportunities



If you have colored slip you will still be able to:

- Band Practice
- Orchestra Practice
- Drama Practice
- Dance Practice

As long as there is room for you, and based on teacher's discretion

# Buff Grade Slip



If you receive a buff grade slip it means you have a C or D grade in some subject.

Please go meet with a teacher and work on any missing assignments or current homework.

It's your choice.

Ask questions. Check Skyward.

Improve your grade in that class, there's probably something **more** you can do!

*Remember that white grades slips get first seating, you may have to meet with a different teacher. You don't have to do Priority Days.*

# Check SKYWARD® Regularly

Being prepared to remediate is essential, so check your Skyward account frequently.

Bring any necessary materials, homework, or instruments.

**Your teacher should not have to tell you what assignments you are missing.**

*\*If you need login information for Skyward stop by the counseling office during your lunch or before school.*

# TEAL Time Detention



If you have behavioral issues, your teacher will send you to TEAL Time Detention. (No more AFT)

1. You will ***call home***, and arrange a time with your parent to stay **AFTER SCHOOL for 30 minutes**.
2. And then you will work on your homework under close supervision for the rest of TEAL Time.

Tardy to TEAL Time will be assigned detention.

Room C111 is the new TEAL Time Detention room (next to Counseling Office)





# Study Hall



If your teacher's room is full, find another teacher to remediate with, *but if all options are exhausted*, then a teacher will stamp your grade slip and you will go to the lunch room for Study Hall.

You will find the lunch table with the *subject* you are remediating and begin working on homework for that class. There will be a teacher or aide available to answer any questions you might have.

*This will be more like Math Lab!*



# Computer Labs

Computers in the building will be used for remediation, homework and assignments only.

English students go to Writing Lab in C112.

***Check with your teacher to find out where you should go to use a computer for your homework or assignment.***

# Teacher not here?



Each department will have a teacher you can work with in the event that your teacher is not here

- Some teachers are B-day only, or A-day only
- Sometimes your teacher will be absent

*Teachers will communicate with students about these unique situations...and put a sign on the door!*
