TEAL Time stands for Teacher Extended Assistance Learning. TEAL Time is a 30-minute segment of the school day schedule, Tuesday-Friday, where students have the opportunity to meet with teachers to work on any missing assignment, retake tests, or improve their grades. We know that for a variety of reasons, students may struggle with certain subjects, or even simply get behind in their work due to absences. We believe it is important to give them the extra time to meet with their teachers while they are here at school, and thus eliminate the need to stay after school or even come in early in the morning.

We have organized our TEAL Time so that we have Priority Days for all subjects so that students can remediate effectively with any/all teachers. Students will know where to go for TEAL Time.

Students are also given the opportunity to participate in Enrichment Activities or extra privileges during TEAL Time when they have completed all necessary work. We provide documentary films, talent sharing opportunities, and have reading time in the Media Center, as well as organized physical activities and sports tournaments. Additionally, students are given the option and provided areas, and computer access to simply work on their homework if they choose.
