*Liz called the meeting to order.

*Holly reviewed the minutes from October meeting.

*Liz gave an overview of the SCC training that she went to. She handed out a responsibilities informational paper. We talked about the Netsmartz assembly we had with our students at the beginning of the year. It was felt that it was a great presentation.
