For your information:

- 1. The test consists of approximately 50 questions with a 90-minute time limit. It will be administered using a computer.
- 2. Three math credits are now required for graduation. Those students who enroll in the accelerated class as 7^{th} graders must complete through Calculus in order to have enough math credits to graduate from high school.
- 3. Keep in mind that some students on the accelerated math path experience math 'burn out' by the time they reach 10^{th} grade because of the difficulty and the fast-paced course. Accelerated students should be organized, dedicated, and have good study habits.
- 4. The class will cover the Intermediate I and Intermediate II curriculum. In 8th grade, students will take Secondary Math I with the 9th graders.
- 5. We will send home a letter after your child takes the test and with their class placement.

Concepts for the test will come from the 6th grade core found at https://www.uen.org. It is our recommendation that students prepare and study for the test.
