IMPORTANT Audition Information Auditions will be August 31, September 1, 2, and 3. Dance Auditions All Students Tuesday August 31 Auditorium 2:15-4:45 p.m. Students are expected to stay the entire time. If you own dance shoes, please wear them, if not, please wear lightweight tennis or gym shoes. No sandals or flip-flops, please. You will not be allowed to dance barefoot or in stocking feet. **In order to audition, you must have your (1) Audition Form completed/signed and (2) Parent/Guardian Survey Form completed/signed (bring both to dance auditions)**

Wednesday, September 1 will be the vocal auditions in the Drama room (146). Students should prepare about 16 measures (no more than 30 seconds) of music to sing, which should NOT include any selections from the show itself. **Audition times will be given at the dance audition.**

Thursday, September 2 Callbacks - After the vocal auditions on Wednesday, a callback list will be posted. **THIS IS NOT A FINAL CAST LIST.** Students called back will not need to prepare any extra material beforehand. Simply plan on meeting in the auditorium from 2:15-4:30 p.m.

Friday, September 3 **Cast list posted entire cast meets for first rehearsal in the auditorium.**

Show Background and Synopsis

___ **Wearable Art Coordinator (1):** This person coordinates the printing of the t-shirts and will work with past coordinators and the directors.

___ **Offstage Parent Coordinator (1):** This person organizes all necessary off stage help for the run of the show and certain dress rehearsals. They will work directly with Miss Sanders and Mrs. Tregagle.

___ **Publicity Coordinator (1):** This person handles promotion of the show online and throughout the community. This includes the design, execution, and distribution of posters and other publicity information. They must also connect with and organize newspaper and other media publicity. This includes the Canyon View newsletter and the Alpine School District newsletter. They must also arrange for design and distribution of the window stickers.

___ **Publicity committee (3-5):** These people will aid the coordinator organizing the publicity for the show.

___ **Program Coordinator (1):** This person is responsible for coordinating the design, execution and organization of the program. This will also include organizing the selling of advertising space in the program. This individual will work directly with Miss Sanders and gather information from previous program coordinators.

___ **Hospitality Coordinators (2):** These people are responsible for arranging for auditorium and guest management and for instructing ushers each evening before performance. This person is also responsible for writing and mailing or delivering thank you notes and other gratuities as required. This person must have excellent writing skills.

___ **Display Board Coordinator (2):** These people must design and execute the display board, set it up before the show and take it down each evening after performance. They must also remove and dismantle the board at the end of the run. This should be an artistic and creative person.
