Counselor Message: The Utah Opportunity Scholarship has replaced the Regent Scholarship

- This scholarship is straightforward and goes to every student who meets the following 4 requirements
- (1) Earn a 3.3 cumulative high school GPA
- (2) Complete 3 advanced courses
 - Complete 1 Advanced Placement (AP), International Baccalaureate (IB), or Concurrent Enrollment (CE) course in each of the core areas of high school graduation:

 - science, and
 - language arts
- (3) Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- (4) Graduate from a Utah high school
- The Opportunity Scholarship can be used at Dixie State University, Salt Lake Community College, Snow College, Southern Utah University, Utah State University, Utah Valley University, University of Utah, Weber State University and the following private, non-profit institutions in Utah: Brigham Young University (Provo), Ensign College, Westminster College, and Western Governors University.
- The "Opportunity Scholarship" is not needs based. There is a needs based scholarship called the "Utah Promise Scholarship".
