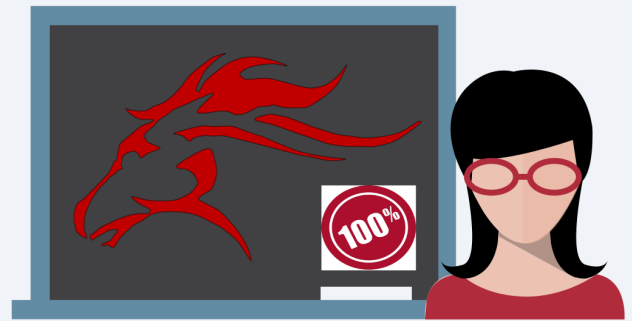

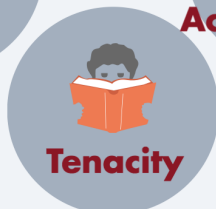

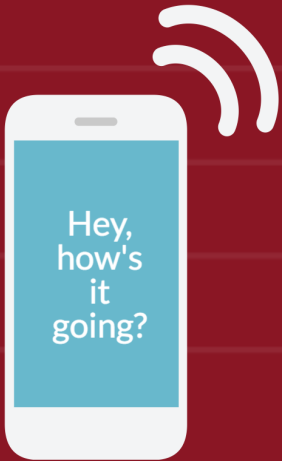





Cell Phones

No clothing or paraphernalia referring to, or promoting, alcohol, tobacco, drugs, illegal substances, violence or sexual harassment.



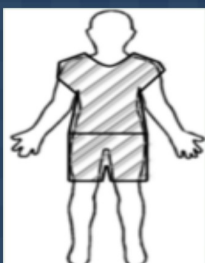
Clothing may not have profanity, innuendos, vulgarity, or any other inappropriate content displayed on it.

Distractions such as sunglasses, extreme hairstyles, inappropriate clothing, etc. will be dealt with on a case to case basis.



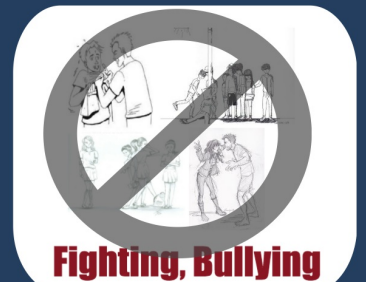
Clothing must cover the shaded area. Skin or undergarments should not be seen in the shaded areas, including through holes, lace, or other sheer material.
