I am excited to be teaching your daughter's Physical Education. I have a love for movement and how exercise can benefit all of us. I love to participate in sports and be physically active. In past years I have had the opportunity to coach basketball and track at Lakeridge Junior High. This has been a great experience for me and I have loved working with many of your children outside of the classroom setting.

This year I was given the opportunity to coach basketball at Mountain View High School. This is a great opportunity for me to learn and grow and one that I am excited about. While the change in coaching venues will not impact what takes place during class it will impact my availability after school. On A days in September and October I will have time commitments at the high school and will not be available after school to work with my students. Basketball season starts at the beginning of November. November through March I will be at Mountain View every day after school and will not be available at Lakeridge. Spring basketball will then begin and I will again be available on B days to work with students after school.

I realize that this limits make-up time in my class. I want to assure you that your child's education is important to me and I will still be available every day before school and during flex on A days. On B days I have been assigned to cover an activity by the principals.

In my disclosure document it states that students have 8 days to make-up assignments when absent. I will now allow students 10 days to make-up work to compensate for my new schedule.
