

Seventh Grade Math Testing

Dear Students and Parents,

Students who will be attending Lakeridge Junior High School and wish to be placed on the accelerated math track in the seventh grade must take two district placement tests. One test is a math aptitude test and one a skills test. These are the same testing and placement standards used to place students in the accelerated math program district wide and are similar to the testing used for placing students in seventh grade algebra in the old core. Students must pass both tests in order to be placed on the accelerated track.

These tests will be given on March 31st & April 1st in the media center at Lakeridge Junior High School. Check in for testing begins at **2:45 p.m.** Please be on time. **Tests will not be given out after 4:00 p.m.** Students with last names from **A-L will test on Tuesday, March 31st,** and students with last names **M-Z test on Wednesday, April 1st.** If possible come on the day assigned. If not, come on the alternate day. Both tests need to be taken on the same day.

Students will need approximately one to two hours for testing. Phones will be available for students to call home when the testing is finished.
