1. Norm Setting/ purpose and guidelines: Each Council member received a copy of Lakeridge SCC Mission Statement and Purpose (attached). 3. New Teachers—Elizabeth Brooks—Math, Tanner Herrick—PE, Danielle Kamalu—Math, Emily Larimar—US History & ESL, Hannah Taylor—Spanish and ESL, Kandis Taylor--Band and Jesse Welsh—Math, Kyle Bond—English, Blake Longmore—GT/History.
4. New meeting time and day decided: 3rd Tuesday of each month, 12:00-2:00pm
5. Data Review: Language Arts increased well above District, state, and even last years results. Math went from 55 to 63. Science jumped from 62 to 66. All levels are higher than state and district results.
6. Hope Squad/X Factor: Combining this year and will be under the Hope Squad umbrella, which centers on suicide prevention. Approximately 35 students met with leaders during the summer to kick-off the year. Students are from diverse groups and grades.
