Our School Community Council is dedicated to the success and achievement of our children. The Utah State Legislature created these councils with three purposes in mind.

The first is “To build consistent and effective communication among parents, employees and administrators.”

Second, “To allow parents an opportunity to be actively involved, with the school, in their children’s education.”

And third, “To enhance academic excellence at the school and address the needs of students.”

The Community Council’s purpose is to advise and make recommendations regarding the school, its programs, and other issues relating to the community environment for students. The Council assists in developing the school improvement plan and School LAND Trust Program. Members of the council are made up of Lakeridge administration, faculty and parents. Service on the committee is a two year term with monthly 2 hour meetings. Elections are held during the fall.

The Council also invites any who would like to attend a monthly Community Council meeting to do so.
