Dear Parent/Guardian,

Your student has failed one or more core classes at Mountain Ridge Junior High School. In order for your student to successfully complete 7th and 8th grades, we recommend your student participate in our credit-recovery packet program. This program allows your student an opportunity to remediate deficient credit and earn an Alpine District Completion Certificate at the end of 8th grade.

We believe our district-wide completion program helps instill in students the importance of education and develops patterns of responsibility and accountability. Additionally, we want our students to be prepared for the rigors of high school curriculum. Studies indicate that the 8th grade year is a pivotal indicator in continuing school success and high school graduation.

To receive the credit-recovery packet, please pay \$20 at the Finance Office and bring the receipt to the Counseling Center. Once the packet is completed and a passing grade earned, we will change the failing grade to pass. All 8th grade students must have their packets submitted by May 16th to qualify for the completion celebration.
