Admission Procedure

To be admitted to one of the programs at MTech a student must do the following:

1. Prerequisites:

- High school students (juniors and seniors) are required to meet with, discuss, and complete their registration with their school counselor, prior to enrollment in MTech programs.
- ALL students are required to complete a basic assessment of reading and math skills. The test is free and takes approximately 1 hr to complete. For additional information, call the Testing Center (801) 753-4110.

2. Complete a registration form for admission.

3. Pay for books and fees. Tuition is waived for all high school students.
