Dear Oak Canyon Parents:

We hope your family has weathered the past year safely. We are all looking forward to brighter days, but we have learned and adapted to our times and plan to move forward with some new ideas.

Unfortunately, *because of Covid, we are not able to have parents attend their student's College and Career Readiness (CCR) meeting in person.* We will be presenting to your students in their US History class on January 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup>. At this time, we will hand out the registration form for 9<sup>th</sup> grade and go over the information on it and high school graduation requirements. Your student is asked to *return the registration form* to their US History teacher the next time they have their class, the 28<sup>th</sup> or 29<sup>th</sup>. We will send a video home to you, explaining how to fill the form out and answering some of the most asked questions. We are in the process of building our **Master Schedule** for next year and in order to offer enough sections of each course, we need to see which classes each student requests.
