

Dear Students

As this school year starts to wind down we are looking forward to the Student Council Elections for the 2021-2022 school year. These elections will take place in the next couple of weeks and we would like to ask for your consideration in running and serving on the Student Council for next year.

How will the elections be done this year?

The election process will have two parts. Part one will consist of six elected Student Body Officers. The Student Body Officers will run a normal campaign with posters, videos, interviews, and in-class elections. All six elected positions will be 9th graders only. Part two will consist of a lottery. The lottery will be used to pick all of the 7th, 8th, and 9th grade rep positions. We will be selecting 5 reps from each grade level. The only prerequisites for entering your name in the lottery is a desire to lead your peers in building a culture of inclusion and acceptance, and a willingness to model the Oak Canyon Values. If you are chosen you will be required to adhere to the Student Council standards of excellence, including in academics (minimum 3.0 GPA each quarter of the next year).

On Tuesday, March 16th at 1:15 PM, we will be holding a meeting for all parents and students of prospective Student Council members. The purpose of the meeting will be to discuss all things Student Council and to help answer any questions or concerns. The meeting will be held in person in the school Auditorium for those that would like to attend in person (we will be observing social distancing rules and masks are required), or you can also join in on a computer at home through Google Meet using the following link: meet.google.com/qyc-fzis-rhz

If you are considering running for any of the Student Council positions, it is required that you read through all the information and are familiar with your obligations, including your academic standing and financial obligations for being a member of the Student Council. When you submit the application it is assumed that you have reviewed all the information with a parent and they are aware and approve and will support you throughout the year in your service as a member of the Student Council.

Once elected, or selected in the lottery, your schedule will need to be modified to add the Student Council class period to your schedule. The class period is B7 and it will be a full year class.
