Dear Students and Parents/Guardians,

The counseling department at Oak Canyon Junior High extends a warm welcome to the incoming 7<sup>th</sup> graders. Our counselors will be coming to each elementary school the first week in March to give a presentation to your 6<sup>th</sup> grade student. It will include information on classes & programs offered, and a 7<sup>th</sup> grade registration packet, which they will bring home. If you do not have questions for the counselors, or need to audition **please complete the packet and return it to the Oak Canyon Counseling Office** by Wednesday, March 9, 2022. If you would like to meet with your counselor, have questions answered, or need to audition, please come during our 7<sup>th</sup> grade registration day, Monday, March 7, 2021, from 3-6 p.m. (see more information below). Resource personnel will be available to discuss IEP's.

If your student attends one of our feeder elementary schools, (Aspen, Lindon, Northridge, Orchard, Rocky Mountain, or Valley View), and you did not get a 7<sup>th</sup> grade registration packet by March 4th, please visit the front office of your elementary school or the Oak Canyon Counseling Office, to pick one up.

***If your student is planning to attend Oak Canyon Junior High next year, but does not attend one of our feeder schools,*** (Aspen, Lindon, Northridge, Orchard, Rocky Mountain, or Valley View), please come to the Oak Canyon counseling office after March 1st, to pick up a 7<sup>th</sup> grade "class registration packet." Please complete the packet and return it during our 7<sup>th</sup> grade registration day, Monday, March 7, 2022 from 3-6 p.m. (see more information below). Resource personnel will be available to discuss IEP'S. If you do not have questions for your counselor, or do not need to audition, **please return the packet to the Registrar in the Counseling Office at Oak Canyon, no later than Wednesday, March 9, 2022.**

## **Monday, March 7, 2022 from 3:00-6:00 p.m. in the Oak Canyon cafeteria:**

Visit with counselors, turn in paperwork, have questions answered, audition for men's/women's chorus, and/or advanced band/orchestra, percussion. (no audition for beginning classes). Resource personnel will be available to discuss IEP's.

If you plan to audition for an advanced music class on Monday, March 7th, please bring your instrument. Vendors will be available to rent instruments for the upcoming school year at this event.
