There are two major changes to our schedule this year: the addition of homeroom 4 times a week, and Wednesday early out day changing from two hours early to only one. Please note the updated bell schedule.

Homeroom: This year, each student will be assigned a homeroom class between A1/B5 and A2/B6. Homeroom is 27 minutes on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday. Students will be mixed with students from their entire grade level as well as some students from the grade level above or below them. The idea for Homeroom came from our teachers as we brainstormed ways that we could intentionally pursue our Vision for Learning as a school and create authentic connections with students. We will be using curriculum from a local company called In Focus to help us deliberately develop the skills and dispositions listed in the message above. The first four weeks of school we will be discussing the following topics: 8/16 What it Means to Be an Eagle/Lifelong Learning; 8/21 Conditions of Well Being (safety, basic needs); 8/28 Connection and Community Building; and 9/4 Academic Skills. In Focus materials for parents will be shared

soon. We are excited about this new opportunity for teachers and students alike.

Wednesday Early Out Day: Please note that school will be adjourned at 1:15 on Wednesdays this year. This means that we will run a two lunch schedule like we do on a regular day and conclude the day with A4/B8 rather than a shared lunch. Please note this change and plan accordingly.

NEW LUNCHROOM PROCEDURE--SCANNING STUDENT BARCODES

The Alpine Nutrition Services Department is switching to scanners for all secondary students during meal service. **Students will no longer be able to key in their student identification numbers. In order to participate in meal service, student ID with a barcode will need to be used.** The scanners are 2D and will scan off phones. The district has a resource with the Skyward App that allows students to get their barcode off the app. We believe this process will help streamline the meal service, and appreciate your support as we transition towards scanners for our schools. CHROMEBOOK CHECK OUT FOR 7TH AND 9TH GRADE STUDENTS

Chromebook Checkout is August 17, 18 and 21. 9th grade checkout is Thursday/Friday (17th/18th) during English and 7th grade checkout is Friday/Monday (18th/21st) during Student Success. **Students will not be permitted to check out a Chromebook without proper parent permissions.** Please refer to the links below to ensure that the process is smooth for your student. It is only offered at the beginning of the school year, and is an affordable option should the unexpected happen to your student's device.
