PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

I will resume spotlighting students and programs next week in my Principal's Message. However, the most urgent message I can convey at this point is the importance of becoming informed about the study conducted by MGT concerning a potential ASD reconfiguration. One way to become informed is to attend one of the three public meetings led by MGT in which they share their findings as well as 6 possible reconfiguration options which include staying together as one district, splitting into 2 districts, and a three-way district split. The first public meeting is Tuesday, March 12 at 7:00 PM at Timpanogos High School. If you are unable to attend, another way to become informed is to watch the presentation MGT made to the ASD School Board on February 27 by clicking on this [link](#). I know there are some figures being shared by

MGT this week that are in addition to what was shared in the presentation made to the ASD Board on 2/27. Please note that at the end of the presentations MGT will be collecting feedback. There will be public hearings on the matter in May, and soon after the Board will make a decision about whether this issue will go on the ballot in November. Please stay informed as this is a decision that will impact citizens, patrons, parents, educators, and students alike.
